- ▶ **Life Orientation is not included** in the AS calculation; unless the applicant is from quintile 1 to 3 schools (see below*);
- ▶ Applicants must meet the direct entry requirements for the relevant qualification (AS + subject+ % required);
- ▶ Applicants can **no longer apply for testing (NBT)** as an alternative route to admission;
- ▶ Applicants can use their **Grade 11 final, Grade 12 June, September or November results (final)** to calculate their AS.

* For those applicants from quintile 1 to 3 schools who attain 50% or higher for Life Orientation, 7 points are added to their score out of 600 to calculate their final AS.
